Fundamental Needs of Mankind

This beautiful, in-depth chart comes with a complete set of materials and research stories for each image. It opens the door for children to study any civilization during any time period, and can be used by Montessori schools, public schools and homeschoolers alike.

The chart is a complex web of categories and sub-categories, each represented by a central node and connected to various circular images. The main categories are: **Spiritual** (with sub-categories: Culture, Religion, Philosophy, Character), **Material** (with sub-categories: Food, Shelter, Clothing, Communication, Transportation, and other unlabeled branches), and **Shelter** (with sub-categories: steel, concrete, clay, mortar, wood, hides, ice, marble, stone, and other unlabeled branches). Shelter - Grass Leaves

Grasses and leaves have been used by peoples to build simple houses, with one or two rooms, for thousands of years. In tropical areas today, millions of people are still building houses this way.

Walls are made of bundles or mats of long grass and reeds tied together. They are laid to and held up by large sticks or bamboo stalks.

Roofs are made of bundles of grass or leaves also, with space to allow breezes to flow through. Large palm leaves are used by people of the Pacific Islands. Some houses are built on wood stilts over water or where it rains a lot.

Older country homes in the British Isles often have thick thatched grass roofs. And in parts of Europe and roofs appear. In the 1800s, sod houses were built on the American plains where there were no trees for lumber.

The picture shows a round house in tropical Africa with a grass roof. Some houses in dry areas have mud or clay walls.

In Japan and parts of the far East where earthquakes occur, bamboo stalks are used to build fairly strong houses.

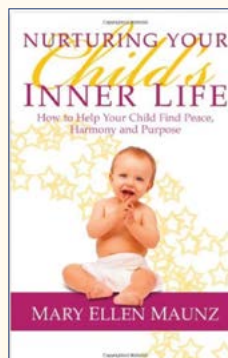
